

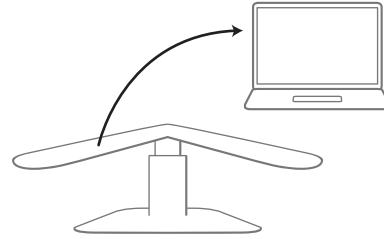

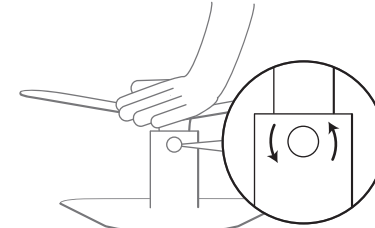


How to adjust the height of HiRise for MacBook

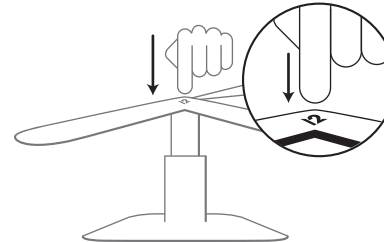
1 Remove MacBook from HiRise



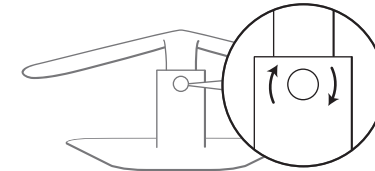
2 With hand placed on top, loosen the screw



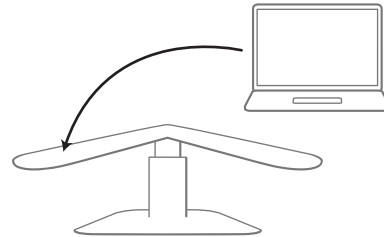
3 Push straight down on the logo to adjust



4 While holding the position, tighten the screw



5 Place MacBook back onto HiRise



6 Add an external keyboard and mouse



Tips and tricks

Press straight down with a finger on the Twelve South logo - and not the arms - when adjusting the height of HiRise. The HiRise arms securely hold your MacBook, but not the weight of your body leaning on it.

When adjusting HiRise, remove your MacBook first. Let your MacBook sit safely aside till all the 'ups and downs' are over. Then make sure HiRise is good and tight before replacing it.

HiRise turns your MacBook laptop into a desktop. It raises the screen to the most comfortable ergonomic height for you (about eye level with the top of the screen). You then add your favorite external keyboard and mouse for desktop use. HiRise is not meant for typing directly on your MacBook - save that for mobile use.

Have a dual-screen setup (MacBook + external monitor)? Adjust HiRise to perfectly match the base of the screen heights. This helps create a seamless visual transition between the two. You don't really want two separate monitors - you want one GIANT super-size monitor. HiRise for MacBook helps achieve this perfect setup.
